The Bloomsburg Area YMCA has "been here for the community" during the COVID 19 Pandemic. Although the state government forced us to close, we still offered our facility to AGAPE who used our parking lot for their weekly food giveaway. The YMCA also hosted several blood drives that raised over 150 units of life saving blood. As soon as we received the green light from the state, we hosted our summer camp and summer swim so our children could have fun, safe activities during the difficult summer of 2020.

This month, starting on June 19 through August 15, the Bloomsburg Area YMCA will begin our annual campaign to raise money that will benefit the youth scholarship fund. Each donation will help families and children access needed equipment, facilities, and programs that will help them lead healthier and happier lives.

While a gift in any amount can make a significant difference in the lives of many children and their families, we have established the following giving levels:

- * \$500 (plus) - will provide five children a week of full day pre school
- *\$200-\$499- will provide four children in need a 1 year YMCA membership
- *\$100-\$199- will help two underprivileged children a month join our swim team program
- *\$1-\$99- can help provide 1 full scholarship for one of our youth sports or dance programs
